For the purpose of clarification the following additions, changes, modifications and replacements noted below have been made to the bid and have been made to the bid file which bears the above title.

Bids submitted shall conform to these additions and modifications noted herein and including all issued addendums.

QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

- 1. Spec calls for a 18.5 Ounce Vinyl. It also says to provide a 5 year warranty. However the 18.5oz vinyl's are a coated product and do not come with 5 year warranties. 18oz Laminated Extruded Vinyl, however does come with a 5 year no fade warranty.
 - Need to know which ounce vinyl to provide as there is a cost difference between the two vinyls?

TSA Response: Our biggest concern is longevity. The vinyl that has a five (5) year warranty is what we need.

- We can send cut sheets over as well.
- 2. The Spec also calls out for plywood. Our standard pad that we have in other NFL Facilities as well and MLB, MiLB, and College Facilities comes with a ³/₄" Advantech Backer Board. I have attached some literature as well. Will this be accepted in lieu of the ³/₄" Plywood?

TSA Response: Yes, this would be acceptable.

1. Page 14, Clause 36 <u>AUTHORIZATION TO DO BUSINESS IN STATE OF FLORIDA</u> indicates that if a company is awarded they must be authorized to do business in the State of Florida *before* beginning any work. If bidder is an out of State Corporation on page 27 bid asks if the bidder is currently certified to do business in the State of Florida. Is it correct to answer "No" for the bid submission understanding that if awarded, bidder would have to complete the registration prior to beginning work?

TSA Response: Yes, answer no. If awarded the contract, you can go to the Department of

Corporations for the State of Florida to register to do business in Florida. You can register and send a receipt of "pending registration" after award of the Contract. There's no need to register if you're not awarded.

1. Page 26 BID PROPOSAL – bidder is instructed to include a unit price and total for 65 pads. In this price will be the cost of materials, labor, travel, lodging, shipping, trash container(s), utility vehicle, etc. for just 65 pads. Is there a reason the costs are not itemized by field pads, installation, shipping as separate line items? Any change in the quantity could unevenly change the cost of any one of the itemized charges like shipping, labor, travel, lodging, trash disposal containers.

TSA Response:

Please include all associated costs as indicated on the bid proposal page. Add your total costs together and divide that total cost by 65 units. If there are issues that require change orders that arise "after award of the contract and work started, a change order may be issued if the Authority deems it is necessary.
